
About the Employee Survey

President David Skorton initiated the Cornell Employee Survey in response to a resolution from the Employee Assembly calling for a study to better understand staff engagement. The resulting survey was administered from October 25 to November 18, 2011. Seventy percent of invited employees responded to the survey, with 5165 surveys submitted over the web and 482 surveys submitted on paper. The survey had 60 multiple-choice questions and one open-ended item. The average completion time for the web-based survey was 11 minutes.


Overall Satisfaction

Overall, how satisfied are you with your job at Cornell?




Other populations at Cornell have been asked similar questions:

- Graduating seniors were asked in Spring 2010, "Overall, how satisfied have you been with your undergraduate education?"








How much do you agree or disagree with the following statements?





How much do you agree or disagree with the following statements?


